It's coming soon...the Yellowstone Square Dance Council meeting on **Saturday**, **May 3 at 5 p.m. at the First Presbyterian Church**.

As previously reported, we'll have election of officers at this meeting. Terms are for two years, and new occupants of the offices of Vice President and Treasurer are especially needed. There is some interest in these offices, but all offices are open to elections this year. None of the offices is labor-intensive; with only three meetings a year with the intention of preserving busness as usual in the square dance community. Remember, current officers are always ready to show new officers the ropes.

We sincerely need you and your ideas. You may have noticed that the square dance community is a little different than many dance communities. We don't just pay a cover, hang out with our friends and then leave when the dancing's done. We're invested in our dance community. We know that it's up to us to keep square dancing alive and we're happy to work together to make that happen.

To do that, we always need fresh ideas and willing hands. In other words, we need YOU! Come to the meeting Saturday and share your bright ideas or pitch in to help make someone else's bright idea a reality.

#### **Magic City Hoedown**

We hope you've picked up the brochure for the Magic City Hoedown, May 17. This will be the first open dance after the graduation of the newest Checkerboard Squares dancers and we're excited to have them join us. In case you missed the brochure, here's a few of the

main points:

There will be five sessions beginning at 9 a.m. with a Round Dance workshop. Larry requests that dancers at this workshop have some Phase 3 level experience. This workshop ends at 10:30.

From 10:30 to noon is a Mainstream dance. This is a dance, not a workshop. It would be great if you newer dancers could come, get warmed up and familiar with Butch's calling so you're ready to dance even more in the evening. If you can't make the afternoon dance, don't worry. Butch is great at putting dancers of all levels at ease.

Plus dancing will happen from 2-3:30 p.m. Then there's Round dancing (pre-rounds) from 7-7:30 p.m. followed by Mainstream dancing until 9:30.

\$25 per person will cover the entire day; or if you want to pick and choose, the morning and afternoon dances are \$10 per person while the evening dance is \$15 per person.
